## Categories of USAID Information

USAID has divided its information into six categories as outlined in ADS 578.3.4. The table below provides examples of information found in those categories and indicates the extent to which the information is covered by the Agency’s Information Quality Guidelines found in ADS 578 and whether that information is subject to peer review.
