- Case finding of the undiagnosed persons with proven strategies in target populations disproportionately affected by the epidemic;
- Adoption of starting treatment on diagnosis, optimizing antiretroviral therapy with the most effective globally accepted regimes, as well as ensuring the most vulnerable populations have easy access to medications;

- Policy and public health systems practices that foster sustainability, help Caribbean countries assume greater responsibility for the HIV response, increase treatment literacy, and reduce stigma and discrimination.
