



REGIONAL YOUTH PARTNERSHIPS

Regional Youth Partnerships is a three-year regional activity that fosters interethnic and cross-border reconciliation among youth from Bosnia and Herzegovina (BiH), Kosovo, and Serbia. The activity is building a network of regional youth from different sectors that engage in hands-on, cross-border community projects to promote reconciliation. By encouraging youth in the three countries to work toward a vision for a better shared regional future, the activity is contributing to USAID's overall goal of a more prosperous and democratic Serbia committed to European integration and self-reliance.

ACTIVITIES

- Establish a Regional Youth Partnerships network of 120 young people from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo and Serbia to help foster stronger regional connections, peace, and reconciliation in the Western Balkans.
- Advance Regional Youth Partnership members leadership capacities, skills, and community engagement.
- Implement joint youth initiatives that contribute to community development and reconciliation in select municipalities.

EXPECTED RESULTS

- Create opportunities for close and lasting regional relationships among youth.
- Trust between youth, their government, and representatives on reconciliation efforts is increased.
- Youth activism, leadership, and participation in reconciliation efforts is increased.
