
USAID Response to Earthquakes in Türkiye and Syria

On February 6, 2023, a magnitude 7.8 earthquake struck central-southern Türkiye—near the Syrian border—and was followed by thousands of powerful aftershocks, including a magnitude 7.5 earthquake. Within hours, USAID deployed a Disaster Assistance Response Team (DART) to lead the U.S. government's response, search for survivors, assess needs, and provide life-saving assistance.

\$185 million in humanitarian aid provided by the United States to support people in Türkiye and Syria affected by the earthquakes.



USAID Disaster Assistance Response Team

The USAID team comprised more than

200 staff at its peak, including 164 searchand-rescue professionals traveling with

12 canines and 170,000 pounds of equipment.

Rescue crews searched for survivors and assessed damage at more than **6,000 buildings** across Adiyaman, Türkiye.

U.S. Humanitarian Assistance

USAID is working with UN, NGO & local partners to deliver vital humanitarian assistance in Türkiye and Syria. To meet needs, USAID **airlifted 1.8 million pounds of relief commodities** from its warehouse in Dubai that were distributed by the International Organization for Migration. USAID also partnered with the UN World Food Program to deliver **1.7 million hot meals & food rations** in both countries. Aid provided includes:

U.S. Military Assistance



In support of USAIDs mission, the
U.S. Department of Defense donated, transported,
and built a **100-bed field hospital** in Türkiye's
Hatay Province. 13 U.S. military helicopters
also conducted nearly **90 flights**, transporting
humanitarian staff and more than **606,000 pounds**of aid for further distribution by Turkish authorities.

Cross-Border Aid to Syria



USAID worked with partners to rapidly scale up cross-border deliveries of humanitarian aid from Türkiye to northwest Syria through 3 border crossings. Nearly **600 UN trucks** carrying medicine, food, and shelter supplies from USAID partners have reached Syria so far.
