The Specialty Coffee Community activity seeks to increase coffee farmers income and profitability through an inclusive approach with buyers, reducing/eliminating inefficiencies and improve quality in their production and processing chains, while increasing access to international certified and specialty coffee markets

HOW DOES SMALL FARMER SOLUTIONS WORK?

This activity reduces and or eliminates field-inefficiencies in the coffee production value chains, lack of consistent quality, and lack of market access led to low prices, losses, indebtedness, and increased pressure to grow coca.

EXPECTED RESULTS

- By the end of the project, 3,200 producers register a profitability of 33% in the production of certified and specialty coffee.
- During the same period, profits from coffee sales will increase from the current 33% loss to 33% profit.
- 12,500 Has of coffee under agroforestry systems.
- Coffee production has increased from 129,400 to 279,800 QQ
