



DEMOGRAPHIC AND HEALTH SURVEY – DHS 2023

January 2018 – June 2023 \$1.9 million

The Angola 2023 Demographic and Health Survey (DHS) project, also known as "Inquérito de Indicadores Múltiplos e de Saúde" in Portuguese (IIMS)", is implemented in collaboration with the National Institute of Statistics (INE) and the Ministry of Health (MoH). This population-based health survey represents the follow up to the 2015/2016 survey which USAID funded (60 percent of total survey costs) with approximately \$5.9 million and provided direct technical support from the USG interagency team in the country.

DHS provides data for a wide range of monitoring and impact evaluation indicators in the areas of population, health, and nutrition helping advance Angola's ability to track progress toward its development goals. The US President's Malaria Initiative through USAID has invested \$1.9 million for the currently ongoing population-based survey that will bring to Angola the power of quality accessible data for strategic programming towards achieving sustainable development.

ACTIVITIES

The 2023 demographic and health survey was designed to provide data for monitoring the population and health situation in angola. The objective of the 2023 DHS is to provide current information with regard to the demographic and health situation of a national representative sample of women, men, and children, including fertility levels, marriage, sexual activity, fertility preferences, family planning methods, childhood and maternal mortality, maternal and child health, breastfeeding practices, nutrition, malaria, HIV/AIDS, domestic violence, and child wellbeing. 2023 data collection has finished and the country is working on analyzing data collected before final report publication (released planned for oct 2024).
